NOTIFICATION

Subject: Amendment of vehicle import quota rules

In keeping with Section 63 (1) of the Pay Structure Reform Act of Bhutan 2022, the Ministry of Finance is pleased to amend the vehicle import quota rules for those in-service public servants eligible for vehicle quota as on June 30, 2023 and not claimed within June 30, 2024 as follows:

1. Timeline to claim vehicle import quota has been extended till **30th June, 2025 with Sales tax and Customs duty on value not exceeding Nu. 0.800 million per quota**. Failure to claim the vehicle import quota within the extended deadline will lead to forfeiture of the quota.
2. The vehicle import quota shall be valid for **seven years** from the date of issue for both serving and retired public servants.
3. For the convenience of the public servants, the **type & make of the vehicle** shall not be mandatory.

This notification shall come into effect immediately.
